

Instructions for Submission of Extended Papers for the CPEM 2020 Special Section of *IEEE Transactions on Instrumentation and Measurement*



Accepted extended papers from CPEM 2020 will be published in a Special Section of *IEEE Transactions on Instrumentation and Measurement* (TIM). Beginning in 2021, TIM will be published online continuously; paper issues will no longer be printed. Each CPEM article will be published individually beginning in January 2021, soon after an author approves page proofs. However, all CPEM articles will listed together in the TIM table of contents.

Each manuscript should be based on a two-page digest published in the CPEM 2020 digest book (proceedings) and presented at CPEM 2020. The manuscript must be significantly extended beyond the digest paper in technical content and research results. Papers longer than 8 pages will be subject to TIM's overlength page charge.

Special Section manuscripts may be uploaded only during the period **August 17 to August 31, 2020**, at <https://www.editorialmanager.com/tim/>. Please do not try to submit your papers earlier because the CPEM Special Section folder in Editorial Manager will not be available. Similarly, do not submit manuscripts later because they will not be accepted.

Please note that accept/revise/reject decisions will be made by the regular TIM editors-in-chief. The function of the CPEM guest editors is to select qualified reviewers and to provide the regular TIM editors-in-chief with recommendations.

New for CPEM 2020: A maximum of 90 manuscripts will be accepted for publication in the Special Section. Accepted manuscripts that do not make it into the Special Section may appear as a future regular paper in TIM, possibly subject to additional peer review. If your paper is not accepted for the Special Section, you may wish to submit it to *NCSLI Measure J. Meas. Sci.* (see http://www.ncsli.org/mj/EB/mj/Measure_Journal.aspx; NCSLI is a partner of CPEM 2020).

Only authors of papers presented at CPEM 2020 are eligible to submit an extended version to the CPEM 2020 Special Section.
